		The student's final grade will appear on both their official high school and college transcripts. <i>(This college transcript is an official college transcript that is guaranteed to transfer to all Colorado public post-secondary institutions and most out of state and/or private institutions. The student needs to contact the receiving school directly.)</i>
		The courses approved in this application are the ONLY classes for which D11 is approving payment. If there is any deviation to these courses or sections without prior, written counselor approval, the student may be responsible for the entire bill.
		If the student withdraws after PPCC's withdrawal deadline, PPCC may record a W on their college transcript and they will not earn high school credit for graduation.
		If the student drops after the drop deadline, they may be responsible for reimbursing D11 for all the tuition paid for that class.
		If the student earns a 2.0 for 2 consecutive semesters, they will be placed on academic probation at PPCC, which will follow them after high school.
		These classes support the student's current ICAP and career goals.
		These classes will be counted as Post-Workforce Readiness electives on the student's high school transcript. Any deviation must be approved in writing by administration.
		D11 pays the current community college rate for tuition (minus COF). <i>If the course is more than this, the student has completed a payment addendum and will pay the difference.</i>
		D11 doesn't pay for fees or textbooks. The student is responsible for paying these fees directly to the college and securing their own textbooks.
		If my student is on an IEP or a 504, FERPA restrict D11 from sharing their plan. The student needs to make an appointment with the OASIS office at PPCC.
		Students are required to attend orientation at PPCC during their first semester.
		The student has met all testing and pre-requisite requirements.
